

MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL MEETING OF THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN  
OF THE CITY OF OSAGE BEACH, MISSOURI

May 1, 2012

The Board of Aldermen of the City of Osage Beach, Missouri, held a Public Forum on Tuesday, May 1, 2012 at 7:00 p.m. at City Hall. The following were present: Mayor Penny Lyons, Alderman Fred Catcott, Alderman Steve Kahrs, Alderman John Olivarri, Alderman Kevin Rucker, and Alderman Ron Schmitt. Alderman Lois Farmer was absent.

Forms were provided to give attendees an opportunity to list their concerns regarding signage for businesses along Osage Beach Parkway. A video of all signage indicating where businesses are located played continuously and Bob Lynch, District 5 Engineer, was on hand to answer questions about signage at different locations. He also answered questions about the intersection at Key Largo but a decision about what to do at that intersection has not been made. Mr. Lynch indicated that Osage Beach Parkway could have been named Business 54 but it would not have had the federal designation. He added that Business 54 refers to a state roadway through an area and the road will be turned over to Osage Beach in the near future. Mr. Lynch was able to answer some questions however; other ideas would be taken back to MoDOT traffic engineers for their review.

Mr. Lynch explained the traffic studies that were done. He said the percentages are holding true as far as where the studies indicated traffic would be after the completion of the expressway.
