**WAIVER OF RIGHTS AND PLEA OF GUILTY**

The defendant appears in person with Attorney /without counsel/. Court informs defendant of the nature of the offense, to-wit: \_\_\_\_\_, range of punishment provided by law and further, defendant is advised as follows:

1. Defendant has the right to a trial to determine his guilty or innocence.
2. Defendant has the right to be represented by an attorney, either one he pays, or if found indigent, one appointed by the Court.
3. Defendant has the right to examine any witnesses presented by the City.
4. Defendant has the right to ask City to compel witnesses to appear by subpoena.
5. Defendant has the right to not make any statements which may be used in the prosecution of the charges filed against him/her.
6. Defendant has the right to appeal the Court's judgement.
7. That there is a possibility the Judge may sentence him/her to a jail term.
8. Defendant has been advised and understands recommendations by a prosecuting attorney or law enforcement officials are not binding on the Judge and may or may not be Accepted by the Judge

The Defendant, having been advised of the above listed rights, hereby does by placement of his/her signature; freely, intelligently and voluntarily waive the above rights and enter a plea of guilty.
