Department Comments and Recommendation:

The proposed water main to Swiss Village Well #3 was originally going to be constructed by City crews, as part of the Swiss Village Well #3 project. It has been decided to hire a contractor to do this work.

The project was advertised Feb. 19, 2020 and the City received four bids on March 17, 2020. The low bidder is Stockman Construction Corp., in the amount of \$92,640.00. We have done work with Stockman Construction Corp in the past with good results. Public Works recommends awarding the construction contract to Stockman Construction.

City Attorney Comments:

Per City Code 110.230, Bill 20-23 is in correct form.

City Administrator Comments:

The first reading was read and passed by the Board of Aldermen on April 2, 2020.

This main waterline construction project is budgeted in FY2020 in the amount of \$100,000; proposed low bid is under budget for line item 30-00-773170.

The new well, project OB19-010 with Heggemann, which is a different piece to the entire Swiss Village Well project, was budgeted in FY2019 (line item 30-00-773170), but work carried over into FY2020; therefore, a budget amendment to 30-00-773170 to carry OB19-010 expenditures into FY2020 based on final approvals that have recently taken place will be brought before the Board upon project completion.

I concur with the department's recommendation.

Department Comments and Recommendation:

On March 31 bids were open for the project known as Mace Road Phase 2A. There were three bidders.

Bids were requested with a base bid for the road only and an alternate bid for the road work and street lighting.

Staff is recommending the board proceed with the road work and street lighting to do all the work at the same time and avoid the necessity of returning to this neighborhood in the future to add the lighting we can include today. The past road reconstruction projects have included streetlights, and while acquiring easements many citizens were in favor of installing the them.

The bid sheet attached shows Cale Seymour Construction, LLC was the low bidder, but we recommend award to Stockman Construction.

The City has not worked with Cale Seymour Construction and references were contacted. The overall comments about quality of work were good, however, there was one comment about watching for change orders. The list of references did not show any completed projects of comparable size and complexity to this Mace Road Phase 2A. The largest completed project listed was \$250,000, with one current project of \$1,000,000. Cale Seymour Construction, LLC was just awarded two projects with MoDOT totally \$350,000.00 starting in 2020. Staff is concerned that this bidder may not have the capacity to complete this project on time and within budget.

Stockman Construction Corporation was the second low bidder with the Alternate bid item. Stockman Construction has a good history with the City. They have completed Nichols Road (\$2.0 million), Dude Ranch Road Sidewalk Phase 4, Dorothy Lane Road Improvements, and Cedar Village Storm Drain Improvements as well as other projects. The Company was the low bidder for the waterline project connecting the Swiss Village Well. On their most recent work with the city two projects Dude Ranch Road, and Dorothy Lane have come in under the contract price and in one instance Nichols Road Reconstruction the change order was initiated by the City not the contractor.

Staff recommends Stockman Construction as the lowest and best bid to complete the entire project successfully.

City Attorney Comments:

Per City Code 110.230, Bill 20-24 is in correct form.

City Administrator Comments:

Mace Road Phase 2a is a FY2020 budgeted project. I concur with staff to award the project with streetlights to Stockman Construction for \$1,163,184.98. Based on the amount budgeted in FY2020, this will be over budget approximately \$35,500 due to the award; however, funding for this will come from our self-restricted funds for this

project.

Phase 1 of the Mace Road Reconstruction project was completed in FY2019 and Phase 2 is scheduled to being in FY2020 but was determined to be completed in two phases beginning in FY2020 (Phase 2b to begin in FY2021). This Phase, Phase 2a, was estimated at \$1.1 million and some funds have been set aside for the entire project as restricted.

I concur with the department's request.
