

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE HOLDING OF AN ELECTION WITHIN AND FOR THE CITY OF OSAGE BEACH, MISSOURI, ON THE QUESTION OF THE APPOINTMENT OF A COLLECTOR AND SETTING THE TIME AT WHICH SAID ORDINANCE SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE.

Be it ordained by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Osage Beach as follows:

WHEREAS, Section 79.050, Missouri Revised Statutes, provides that the Board of Aldermen may provide by ordinance, after approval of a majority of the voters voting at an election at which the issue is submitted, for the appointment of a Collector; and

WHEREAS, the Board deems it advisable and in the best interests of the citizens of the City of Osage Beach to appoint a Collector;

WHEREAS, the duties of the Collector are currently being performed by the City Clerks and the City Treasurers office.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF OSAGE BEACH AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That an election shall be and the same is hereby called and ordered to be held in the City of Osage Beach, Missouri, on the 2nd day of April 2024, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified electors of said city the following proposition:

Proposition No. A

Shall the Board of Aldermen of the City of Osage Beach, Missouri, provide by ordinance for the appointment of a Collector as provided for by the Statutes of the State of Missouri?

Section 4. Within ten (10) days after the approval of this ordinance by the qualified voters of City of Osage Beach Missouri, the City Clerk shall forward to the Director of Revenue of the State of Missouri by United States registered mail or certified mail, a certified copy of this ordinance together with certifications of the election returns and accompanied by a map of the City clearly showing the boundaries thereof.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.

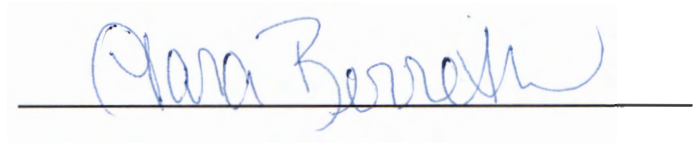
